## Over 60's Lunch Club

Organised by LGVA and subsidised by the local council through Meals on Wheels, lunches were provided for a small cost in the hall for the over 60's once or twice a week until the mid 1990's when demand had dwindled.

Organised to help senior citizens visit friends and relations in hospital or at home. Transgreen met with limited response., and despite а good number drivers. volunteer there was virtually no take-up of the scheme.

The Helping Hand Group was established in 1977 and ran for about 25 years. It eventually merged with the *TRANSGREEN* project established in 1974

The Group was made up of voluntary drivers who either regularly or occasionally undertook odd-jobs and provided much needed help to elderly or disabled residents by giving lifts to Dr's surgeries, hospitals etc. Members of the group displayed a green hand in their windows.

## **Youth Club**

The Youth Club was organised on Friday Nights in the hall by local volunteers and continued intermittently (depending on demand and number of adult volunteers) through to the late 1980's.
